Understandably, considering the all too human nature of his job, Roberts has moments where he has cause to wonder how long he can keep going in an environment that gives so much, but also takes in kind.

It is virtually impossible not to be moved by what we see in From Music Into Silence. Sure, there is sorrow, pain and despair captured by the cameras, but with it all comes a lightness and spirit that both comforts and lifts the viewer.
